

HOO ISLAND – PORT OF SHEERNESS EARTHWORK **RE-ENGINEERING**

A project completed ahead of schedule, a safety challenge met and the re-engineering of some 170,000m³ of material were some of the successes achieved by Land & Water in this complex project for Peel Ports Group.

The long-term integrity of the perimeter bunds and the introduction of an enhanced wildlife habitat/wetland were required despite serious access issues and a 24/7 working timetable to reduce shipping disruption.

Project Delivery

- 170,000m³ of material re-engineered to ensure the integrity of the perimeter bunds
- 125 acre wildlife habitat/wetland created
- Site access restricted to 1-2 hours either side of high water
- All labour, plant and material mobilised to the island by pontoon and barge via Chatham Docks
- Site accommodation and welfare provision provided on site to facilitate 24/7 working
- Safety on this remote location secured by strict procedures and working methods
- Zero waste policy and other early contractor involvement (ECI) inputs resulted in the works completed 8 weeks ahead of schedule

Collaborative working with all parties also enabled savings and efficiencies that helped bring the project in ahead of time.
