



## LONDON SPOT DREDGING

The Canal & River Trust owns and operates numerous mooring sites in London which need occasional spot dredging.

As a trusted project partner, Land & Water was instructed to remove build ups of silt and debris at several sites during works at the Olympic Park.

### Project Delivery

- Land & Water cleared the following sites within the Olympic site: Three Mills Moorings, Carpenters Lock & City Mill Lock, Cumberland Basin, Hormead Wharf, Lisson Grove Moorings, Ice Wharf, Atlip Road Moorings.
- Works were carried out in a linear way (from west to east) to ensure all dredging was carried out systematically. Ultimately, this reduced dredging and travel time, disruption to users and costs, whilst providing the client with the best value for money.
- London waterways are extremely busy and can become congested. Land & Water ensured that its work was carried out efficiently while being considerate to other moorers and boat traffic. This made sure that the impact and disturbance on the community surrounding the project was kept to a minimum.
- Removing the material from the hoppers once dredged was challenging due to a lack of access to the network in London. Fortunately, Land & Water is accustomed to adapting its approach to best suit the landscape in which it works.
